Parking:

Your vehicle can be parked in any empty space at the front of the building. Please use only 1 space per suite.

If you are staying in the 2 bedroom home please use the driveway as your parking space. It is suitable for up to two vehicles.

If you have extra vehicles please park on the public street in city designated parking zones.

Suite Access:

On the morning of your reservation you will receive an email and text message with your suite number and key code. Please use this code on the keypad outside your door to unlock and lock your suite.

If you did not receive a code please check in at our front office so we can update your payment method and provide you a key code.

Key codes become valid at check in time and expire at check out. Locks are set to automatically lock after 10 minutes.

HOW TO...

- TV:** Televisions are equipped with shaw cable. To turn on the TV select the TV button on the remote and push the power button. To turn on cable select the cable button on the remote and push the power button.
- Temperature Controls:** To control heating use the thermostat located on the wall. Air conditioning is provided via a separate portable unit. To control air conditioning use the controls located on the unit.
- Community BBQ:** A community BBQ is located at the rear of the check in office. Feel free to use it to prepare your lunch or dinner, remember to leave it clean for the next guest.
- Complimentary Items:** Our front office offers a collection of books, games, and playing cards. Please return items before your check out.
- Room Cleaning:** Our rooms are cleaned prior to your arrival. We do not provide daily cleaning services.
- For extended stay reservations, cleanings will be done weekly between the hours of 9:00 am to 5:00 pm.
- If additional cleaning is required during your stay please inform our front desk. We will do our best to fit it in.
- Septic System:** Items to not flush or put in drains include cigarette butts, paper towels, sanitary products, wipes, diapers, plastics, food waste, and cooking grease.

Distance: 15.0 km (18 minute drive)
About: Open every Saturday, from May until October. Four winter markets are hosted at the Shatford Centre for the Performing Arts during November and December.

BEACHES/PARKS

Beaches/Parks:	Name:	Wharf Park
	Address:	1 Street, Naramata (Wharf Park)
	Distance:	350 m (4 minute walk)
	About:	Located along the shore of Okanagan Lake, Wharf Park used to be a main port for the BC Fruit Packing House. Take a stroll along the pathway to the end of the dock, which offers picturesque views of the lake. Amenities include; grassy area, shade trees, walking path, and seasonal farmers market.
	Name:	Manitou Park
	Address:	Old Main Road, Naramata
	Distance:	600 m (8 minute walk)
	About:	Located along the shore of Okanagan Lake. Manitou Park is a great space to come on a nice day. Play at the park, run in the grass or organize a game of volleyball. Amenities include; grassy area, shade trees, playground, volleyball court, baseball diamond, and sandy beach.
	Name:	Three Mile Beach
	Address:	Three Mile Road, Penticton
	Distance:	8.7 km (10 minute drive)
	About:	Three Mile Beach is located on Okanagan Lake at Three Mile Road, just off Naramata Road. Parking is limited. Walk down the wooden steps for stunning views of Okanagan Lake. This area features two beaches - one for swimming (clothing option beach) and one for day moorage boating. On the other side of the parking lot there is a dog beach.

BEACHES/PARKS

Beaches/Parks:

Name: Creek Park
Address: 1225 Upper Deck Road, Naramata
Distance: 1.8 km (26 minute walk)
About: A hiking trail that follows Naramata Creek leading to a canyon-like area and waterfalls. Approximately 2.4 km hike round trip, takes an hour with children. First part of the trail has an outhouse at the trailhead, well maintained bridges, and a picnic bench.

Name: Okanagan Beach
Address: Lakeshore Drive, Penticton
Distance: 15.1 km (18 minute drive)
About: Okanagan beach runs along Lakeshore Drive from the SS Sicamous sternwheeler to the Penticton Lakeside Resort. It is on a busy street surrounded with many restaurants, city parks, an inflatable water park, and a kids amusement park.

Name: Skaha Lake Park
Address: Skaha Lake Road & Parkview Street, Penticton
Distance: 20.0 km (25 minute drive)
About: Skaha Lake Park includes one of BC's most beautiful sandy beaches. Amenities include ice cream and fast food stalls, playground, splash pad, volleyball court, tennis court, picnic areas, fire pits, and a marina.

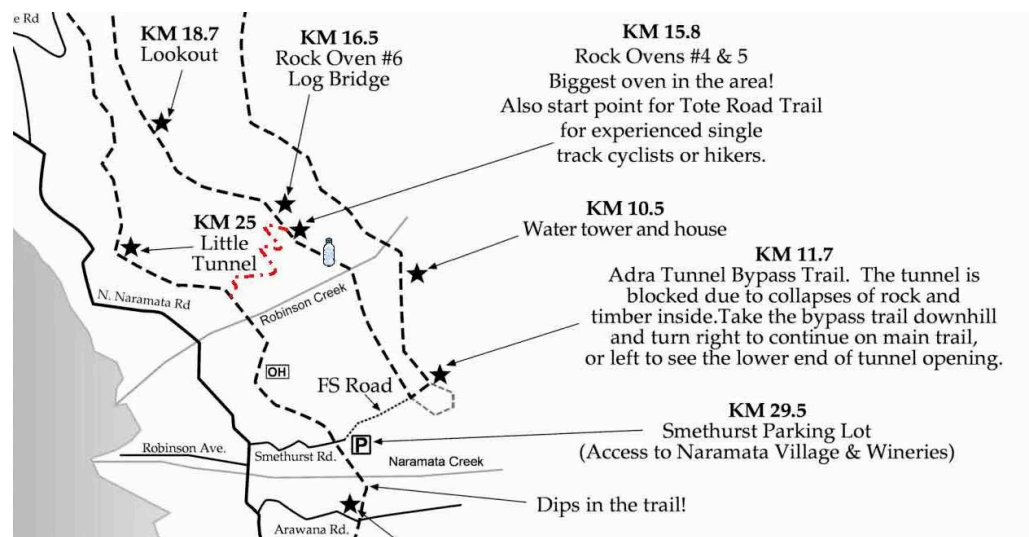
HIKING

About: The Kettle Valley Railway is one of the most remarkable sections of railway ever built in North America. It stretched from Mid-Way to Hope, Via Penticton. The route was carved out of the most rugged terrain. Although the Trains have stopped running, you can still explore the old routes, and see the stunning views for your self. The rails have now been lifted and turned into a linear park with flat trails suitable for hiking and biking.

Directions: From Naramata there are two options for hiking trail routes. The first option is to head south on the KVR, towards Penticton. The second option is to go North towards the Little Tunnel, and connection with the “Trans Canada Trail”. The Smethurst Road Parking Lot in Naramata is the start of the trail.

Detailed driving instructions:

- Drive North along Naramata Road. The turn you want is just after the main turn off for Naramata centre (look out for Robinson Road, where the road forks).
- Soon after you will see the turn off for “Smethurst Road” on your right. It is small and easy to miss, so keep an eye out.
- Keep following Smethurst up, past houses and “Bench Mark” bed and breakfast. You will arrive at the parking area. Here you will find washrooms, and signs for the start of the Kettle Valley Railway Trail!
